Cut crusts off stale bread. Cut bread into 2-inch strips. Soak strips in sweetened condensed milk and roll in coconut. Bake on ungreased pan at 350 degrees until lightly browned.

## Greek Cookies (or Wedding Cookies)

1/2 cup confectioners sugar
1/2 cup Crisco
1/2 cup real butter
2 cups flour
1 tbsp vanilla
1/2 cup chopped walnuts
1 tsp almond extract
Cream the first three ingredients and add the rest. Use electric mixer. Form by hand into small round balls and bake at 375 until only lightly browned, Roll in powdered sugar.
